



**2007 TRUMPOUR'S MILL
ESTATE BOTLED CHARDONNAY
VQA PRINCE EDWARD COUNTY VQA**

THE WINERY: The father/daughter team of Robert and Caroline Granger has poured their passion for viticulture and their love for Prince Edward County in to what is undoubtedly one of the grand wineries in the region.

With 60 acres of vineyards, a pastoral setting and a dramatic tasting room housed in a beautifully restored barn, The Grange is the Loyalist version of a French wine estate – complete with rich textures, historical outbuildings and old-world ambiance.

THE WINE : 2007 Trumpour's Mill Estate Bottled Chardonnay VQA Extended lees contact gives this pale straw estate wine an interesting complexity with a lively fruit nose including melon, peach and apple notes. The palate has apple notes and defined minerality with a long refreshingly crisp and lingering finish.

The complex flavours in this wine make it ideal for sipping or serving with pasta in a cream sauce or grilled whitefish.

ACCOLADES:
Rod Phillips - "There's quite intense extraction here, with sweet and reasonably complex fruit flavours. The acidity included a slightly bitter note at first, but as this wine improved in the glass over time, I suggest decanting/aerating it. Then drink it with chicken or pork. " ★★★★★
