THE WINERY: The father/daughter team of Robert and Caroline Granger has poured their passion for viticulture and their love for Prince Edward County in to what is undoubtedly one of the grand wineries in the region.

With 60 acres of vineyards, a pastoral setting and a dramatic tasting room housed in a beautifully restored barn, The Grange is the Loyalist version of a French wine estate – complete with rich textures, historical outbuildings and old-world ambiance.

THE WINE: 2007 Trumpour's Mill Estate Bottled Pinot Gris VQA

This surprisingly rich pale straw estate wine has an apricot nose, a full mouthfeel and a crisp elegant minerality on the finish.

The delicate flavours in this wine make it ideal for sipping or serving with risotto, veal in a light cream sauce or cheeses.
